

## Crossover Classes

**Class Designation:** PST

**General Safety:** All riders must have full leathers (zipped together leathers are recommended and may be mandatory in future). All riders must have a SNELL 10 or higher full-face helmet with shield, leathers gloves, and shoes above the ankle. All motorcycles and riders must pass the track's safety inspection. Tether kill switches required on all entrants. Kill switch, when activated, must disable ignition, fuel pump(s) and nitrous system solenoids.

**Crossover Rules:** The crossover classes below run under their own set of class rules and ignore the XDA rulebook.

**Engine Containment System:** An engine containment diaper with pigmat is required.

Sanction	Class Name	Eligibility
FIM European Series	Super Street Bike	Any Bike & Rider that actively competes in FIM sanctioned events of the same year or previous year in the European Super Street Bike class may crossover under their own rulebook and run in XDA's Pro Street class. American riders cannot compete on a European bike that was shipped over unless they were also actively racing that same bike in the UK. Bikes must conform 100% to their own crossover rules and cannot deviate in any way, even if the XDA rulebook allows something different.
