

2026 RULEBOOK **BOOSTED BULLS**

Changes from last season are made in **BLUE**.

Revisions during the season are made in **RED**.

CLASS DESCRIPTION: This class is designed for the fastest Boosted grudge bikes.

FORMAT: This is an 1/8 mile, heads-up, no time class run on a .400 pro tree and limited to 16 entries.

POINTS: This class will be a points class at all XDA events.

TRANSFERING ENTRY FEE: We will allow racers to "transfer entry fee money" to another bike if your bike is broken. You can sell your spot and transfer it to another bike all the way up until the **chip draw**, but you must notify the tower. You may also substitute another rider, but you must notify the tower and have them sign a waiver before the first round.

ELIMINATIONS: We always strive to complete the Bulls eliminations on Saturday. However, if time or weather delays prohibit that we will run or finish eliminations on Sunday with the scheduled pro rounds.

SINGLE ENTRY: Bike cannot be entered in more than one Bulls Class. Rider cannot ride more than 1 bike in the same class.

SAFETY: Full-face Snell: M2015, M2020, M2025, SA2015, SA2020, SA2025, FIA: 8860-2010, 8859-2015, 8859-2024 or 8860-2018 helmet mandatory with shield. All riders must have leather jacket, leather pants and leather gloves. Shoes above the ankle are mandatory.

RIDER AGE: All participants must be at least 16 years old with a valid state driver's license. If you do not have a valid state driver's license, then you must be at least 18 years old. All riders must be able to present their State Issued ID card upon request at tech inspection. Anyone caught racing underage without a valid state driver's license will be disqualified with no refunds, and you can be suspended from the XDA indefinitely.

PAIRINGS: We will draw chips for the Bulls ladder and use the same ladder throughout eliminations.

LANE CHOICE: Riders will flip their own coin for lane choice each round.

CLASS BIKE RULE: Any class bike that has shown their time in the last 12 months cannot enter this class. Any dispute regarding a bike's eligibility to enter this class must be made prior to the ladder being drawn by another racer and event director will make final decision.

TIMESLIPS: In the event that there is a time slip printer failure and you need to pick up your time slip in the tower, only the rider whose name is on the tech card may pick up the timeslip and they must bring their ID to the tower with them. This is done to protect the privacy of your time slip, as anyone can falsely claim they are on the team or own the bike.

DIAPER: An engine containment diaper with pigmat is required.

POWER ADDERS: No power adder restrictions.

WHEELBASE: No wheelbase restrictions.

TIRES: 7" slick or DOT tire permitted.

CLUTCH: Any clutch is permitted.

WHEELIE BARS: No wheelie bars allowed.

GROUND CLEARANCE: The motorcycle must have a minimum of 2" ground clearance with rider sitting on the bike. Bikes equipped with a billet flat oil pan (not cast) are exempt from the 2" ground clearance check.
